Meeting Minutes

October 8, 2018

**CALL TO ORDER** Robinson Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, October 8, 2018 at 6:00 pm. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Rodger Kendall at 6:05 pm.
